FERRINGTON VILLAGE TRAVEL GUIDE!

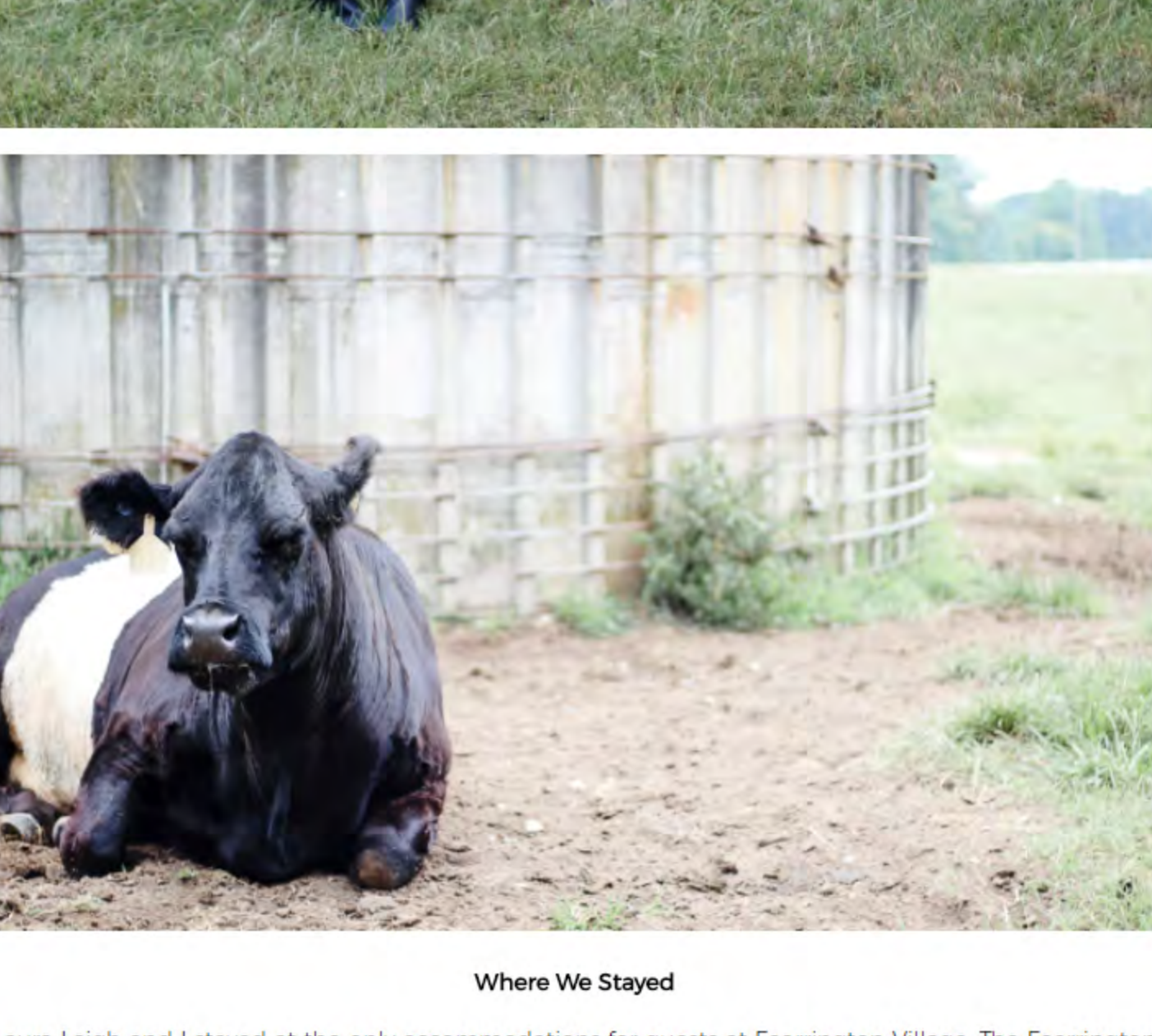

History of Ferrington Village

It was originally a farm owned and operated by RB and Jenny Fitch and was redefined and molded into the village it is today. By the mid-1970's the "farming era" of Ferrington Farm was coming to a close and the Fitch's decided to reinvent their land and property into one of NC's first planned developments, Ferrington Village. The first house was completed by 1976 and was the start to what you see there today. When you drive up, it is truly magical seeing the Belted Galloway cows (also known as Beltie's!) and being surrounded by a quaint village that has so many things to do, see, and eat all in one area! After sitting down for coffee with Missy, the Marketing Manager, one morning we learned a lot about the village and really got a sense of the culture at Ferrington. Where We Stayed

Laura Leigh and I stayed at the only accommodations for guests at Ferrington Village, The Ferrington House Inn. We stayed in a beautiful room with 2 queen sized beds, heated tile bathroom floors, a sitting area, and the prettiest touches of blue throughout the space! We were blown away by the kindness and attentiveness of the staff! Funny story, when we came back from dinner our door was not fully closed or locked and we felt like the biggest idiots ever and were like, "how did we not lock the door?!" 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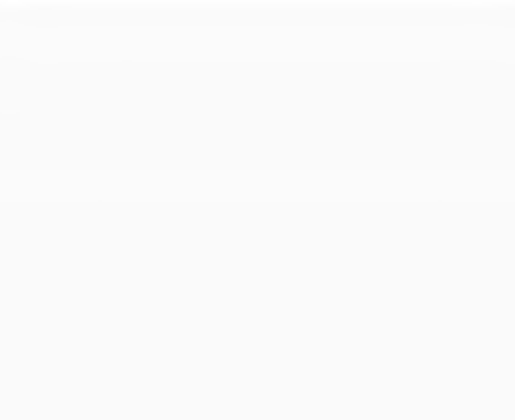
